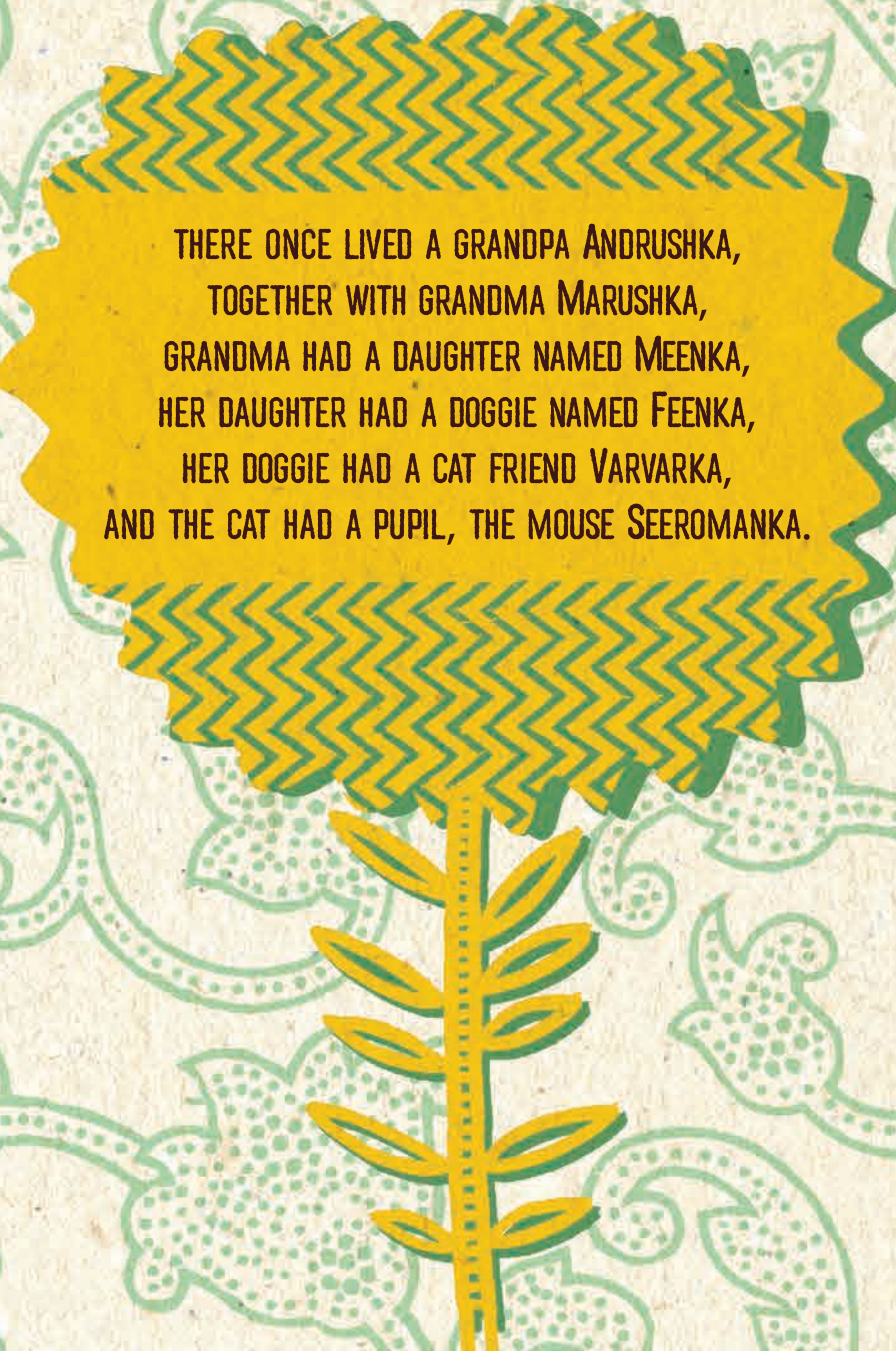




THERE ONCE LIVED A GRANDPA ANDRUSHKA,
